



- 1) Classes: Senior Known (age 50+), Open, Hunter (Fixed Pin), Olympic Recurve, Traditional, High School Open, Middle School Open, Elementary School Open
- 2) 20 targets will be used. 1 arrow per target. If more than 1 arrow from an archer hits the same target, the archer gets the value of the lowest scoring arrow.
You are only allowed to shoot the number of arrows equal to the number of targets on the lane. If you shoot more than that number, you will get the quantity of the lowest scoring arrows for the number of targets. (for example, if you shoot 3 arrows scoring a 10, 10, miss. You would mark the scorecard as a 10 and a miss. If you shoot 4 arrows score a 12, 12, miss, miss, you would mark the scorecard as a miss and a miss. If one of your arrows hits a target on another lane, it counts as a miss on the lane that you are shooting and you cannot count that arrow for the wrong target).
- 3) You must have 1 foot touching the lane number sign when shooting.
- 4) Shooting lanes will be set up with 2 targets per lane. If you shoot a lane and don't have enough arrows for the two targets on that lane, then you will score a zero for each target that you are unable to shoot. Bring the appropriate number of arrows.
- 5) Distances may not be on the scorecards, but range finders are allowed. Max distance is 30 yards. All archers will shoot the same distance (exceptions may be made for Minor shooters).
- 6) Maximum arrow size is 27/64 including arrow wrap.
- 7) Maximum arrow speed is 280fps +/- 3% using the ASR speed gun and may be checked
- 8) Entry fee is \$20. You may enter more than once, but your highest score is the only one that counts. You may shoot in more than 1 class, but the entry fee must be paid for each round shot.
- 9) You will not be allowed to go down range until the all clear is sounded. Repeated violation of this rule will result in disqualification.
- 10) Once you start a round, you may not leave to finish at another time. If you need a brief break for a rest, to use the restroom, or a repair, let an official know and time will be allotted for this. However, this time will be limited.
- 11) Scoring will be done as:



upper 12 must be called.
otherwise it is a 10.
only 1 12 is active per
arrow. other 12 is scored
as 10.
lower 12 is the live 12 if
nothing is called.

- 12) Scores must be marked on official scorecards. Double scoring will be used whenever possible. Scorecards must be signed by both the archer and scorer, if available.
- 13) If you are unable to attend the awards ceremony, please leave your name and address on the registration form and your position finishing award will be mailed to you, if you win one.
- 14) Only First, Second, and Third places in each class will receive an trophy/award.
- 15) Payout will be 1 in 4. A class must have at least 4 entries to have a voucher payout, but if they have fewer than 4, a trophy/award will still be given. 80% of the entry fee will apply toward the payout. The payout will be as a voucher for the Archery School of the Rockies Pro Shop.
- 16) If there is a tie for 1st place, then the appropriate number of places will be split amongst the tiers. (i.e. if 2 archers tie for first place, then the first and second place payouts will be added together and split evenly. If there is a 3-way tie, then 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place payouts will be added and split evenly).
- 17) **Protests are not allowed.** The tournament director's decision is final. However, friendly suggestions and advice are always welcome.
- 18) **Any unsafe behavior will result in immediate disqualification!!!!!!!**
